At the sixty-third session of the World Health Assembly held in Geneva in 2010, the World Health Organisation took a decision which urged the member states to adopt **Patient Blood Management (PBM)** system with the purpose of ensuring quality, safety and effectiveness of blood and blood products. EU member countries implemented their national projects to comply with this decision.

Within this framework, the Project titled “**Technical Assistance for the Improvement of Blood Transfusion Management System in Turkey**”, co-financed by the European Union and the Republic of Turkey, has been initiated by the Turkish Ministry of Health on 20 March 2019. The project focuses on patient blood management.

Objectives of the Project:

- To improve the capacity of the Ministry of Health and relevant stakeholders within the scope of patient blood management;
- Raising awareness about patient blood management;
- Conducting scientific and technical studies on various aspects of patient blood management and blood transfusion along with suggestions for improvement of blood transfusion system
- Establishing cooperation and coordination mechanisms with stakeholders on patient blood management.

The main goal of the project, that is carried out by the General Directorate of Health Services, Department of Blood and Blood Products, is to prepare a National Patient Blood Management Strategy and Action Plan and make it a part of the National Health Policy.
